

Personnel -- CertifiedSubstitute Teachers

A substitute teacher shall be a person qualified by law to instruct in our schools and who is employed for short periods of time in the absence of the regular teacher.

Suitable programs for training, assigning, orienting and evaluating the work of substitute teachers shall be provided by the certified staff at the direction of the Superintendent.

Rates of compensation for substitute teachers will be set by the Board of Education on the recommendation of the Superintendent.

Substitute teachers will not participate in the health and welfare plans or other fringe benefits of the school system.
