

Personnel -- CertifiedTutoring

It is expected that every effort will be made to resolve the learning problems of a student at school before the recommendation that parents engage a tutor or seek other outside professional help. The Board of Education believes that by maintaining high quality instructional staff and providing for a rich, varied curriculum the need for individual tutoring is minimized.

Personnel -- CertifiedTutoring

Teachers employed by the Weston Board of Education may tutor pupils of the Weston Public Schools for pay provided that:

1. The tutoring begins not earlier than 1 hour after the daily closing of school.
2. The pupils are not students enrolled in any class taught by the tutor.
3. School premises are not used for the tutoring sessions.
4. No school system grades or credits are given for the tutoring work.
5. Teachers interested in serving as tutors register in the guidance office with the list of available tutors made available to parents upon request.
6. The tutor files notice in the guidance office that tutoring arrangements have been made.
7. Parents/guardians are fully informed that the agreement for tutoring and any financial arrangements thereto are strictly between the parent/guardian and the tutor and is not sponsored or approved by the Weston Public Schools.

Parents and/or guardians wishing an exception to this regulation may refer their request to the Superintendent of Schools.
