

Personnel -- CertifiedStaff/Student RelationsConfidentiality

In the normal course of school operations, students seek out staff members, for advice and help. Staff members should honor students' confidential information. Confidentiality does not apply when a student threatens to harm him/herself or others. Discussion of suicide, extortion, vandalism or other acts of hostility do not qualify as confidential information. This information is to be reported to an administrator or counselor promptly.

Public discussions of students and their families can be misinterpreted, therefore these matters should be discussed only in professional meetings, not informally in the teacher' room or in other public settings.
