

Community RelationsVisitors to the Schools

The Weston Board of Education and staff of the Weston Public Schools (“the District”) welcome and strongly encourage members of the community and other interested persons to visit the schools. Most visitors recognize the delicate balance between a school’s desire to welcome visitors and its need to maintain a safe, secure, uninterrupted learning environment. Therefore, visitors should abide by the established administrative regulations and applicable school rules governing their arrival, presence, and departure so that the learning, welfare, and safety of the students in the schools are not compromised.

The Superintendent, or his/her designee, is authorized to restrict visitors on District property, to the extent permitted by law, when he/she determines, in his/her sole discretion, that the presence of visitors may be disruptive to the educational process or pose a safety risk to the students, staff and/or visitors to the District, or is otherwise inappropriate.

The Superintendent, or his/her designee, may prohibit specific persons from entering District property or portions thereof, to the extent permitted by law, when he/she determines, in his/her sole discretion, that the presence of a person(s) may be disruptive to the educational process or pose a risk to the safety of the students, staff, and/or visitors to the District.
